### 1. Outcomes

Do programs have to address all 4 -program outcomes?

No. On page 3 of the RFP it states:

Funded Services must address and measure at least one of the following outcomes:

- Increased access to a package of support services
- Reduced caregiver burden
- Extended time care can be provided at home
- Increased caregiver confidence and capacity to provide care

Is there a benefit to doing so?

The outcome selected should tie directly to and a result of the specific activities that the program offers. Therefore, not all of the outcomes may be appropriate for a particular program.

### 2. Does the RE-AIM process have a role in this RFP and if so what is it?

The RE-AIM process does not have a role in the RFP.
